Eminent Death Prevented by Mothers Instinct

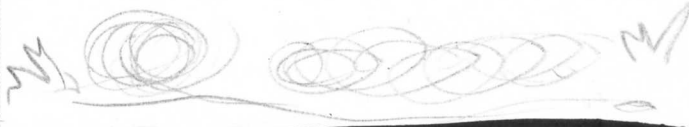


Mother tells father what happened

and conceives his child.**

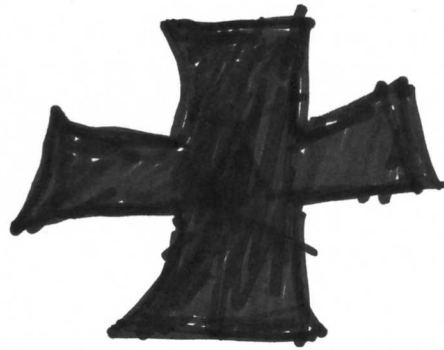
**The Magi gives them a

the baby**



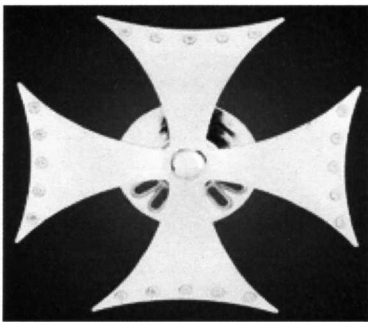
**His mother watched

not scare the bird away.**



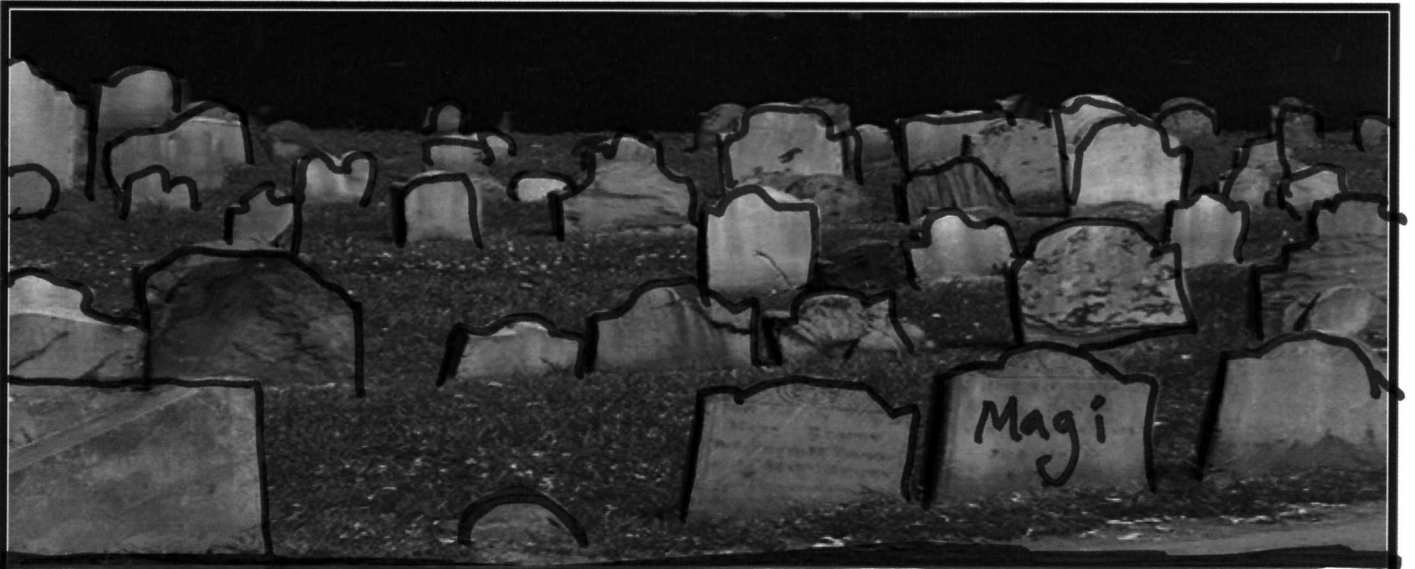
The Bird Returns
